## Peer Review Programme—Call for Reviewers

Peer review will commence September 2023 and run through to 2025 and will look at the care of children, young people and adults with haemoglobin disorders across England

For professional reviewers, this counts as CPD and you will need to have 2 years experience working at the role you will be undertaking and your line manager’s approval to take part.



### Who can be a reviewer

- Patients and Carers
- Consultant Haematologists
- Consultant Paediatricians
- Nurses
- Allied Health Professionals
- Service / Operational Managers
- Commissioners of Haemoglobinopathy Services

All Reviewers will need to have undertaken reviewer training
